Good morning, Everyone

Today is the day that New Brunswick has lifted restrictions for the general public.

Long-term care home restrictions have NOT been lifted and all infection prevention and control measures remain the same at Loch Lomond Villa including the completion of a POCTest upon arrival.

Over the last 2 weeks, we have had to declare an outbreak in our homes. **All Houses except Birch House** has had or currently has a COVID-19 positive case. You will notice staff and some families that will be required to wear full PPE when in some of our resident's rooms.

Unfortunately, we have had to keep our residents back on their houses and cancel all gatherings off the houses at this time.

ECPs may visit only their loved one within the home and must stay in their room while visiting due to outbreaks on the houses. ECPs must continue to wear continuous eye protection and a medical grade mask when visiting in the nursing home and while in your loved one's bedroom. ECPs can alternate day to day visitation but only one ECP may visit per day. If your loved one is in isolation, please do not relax your infection control practices while visiting as your mask cannot be removed and PPE must be worn. This is for your safety as well as everyone else's.

A big thank you to our family members that offered to assist our care team on the house where residents have had to isolate. This help has been very much appreciated by everyone, especially the residents who has had their loved one beside them while they are in isolation. Ongoing testing continues and the POA of any resident who tests positive, is being notified by the RN. Regular communication will occur to keep you informed as time permits.

Protecting our residents has always been a priority and will continue to remain a priority as we enter this new phase of living with COVID-19. Thank you for your cooperation.
